<p>Employees apply for their TAP voucher through EdAssist. Select "Personal Development" not "Professional Development" for voucher</p> <p>Link to EdAssist: https://UAWGM.EdAssist.com</p> <p>Employees print and sign their TAP voucher</p> <p>Employees complete an online application at www.pennfoster.edu/partners/GM-UAW and attach a copy of the signed TAP voucher</p> <p>Once approved, learner will receive an email confirming enrollment and next steps</p> <p>Day the semester starts (every Monday now) learner receives student ID needed for logging in to student platform</p>	<p>Applicants who are not eligible for TAP benefits for the STARC program, as well as students who fail a course and want to retake it complete a separate online application at the self-pay application site: www.pennfoster.edu/partners/GM-UAW-selfpay</p> <p>Applicants must provide credit card information for payment</p> <p>Once approved, learner will receive an email confirming enrollment and next steps</p> <p>Day the semester starts (first Monday of the month) learner receives student ID needed for logging in to student platform</p>
